Paying for Child Care in the Region

State of VT Child Care Financial Assistance Program

The **State of VT Child Care Financial Assistance Program** helps families pay for registered and/or licensed care based on income. In 2024 major updates were made to the income eligibility requirements for the program.

• Eligibility:

- Residents of Vermont
- o Be currently employed, seeking employment, or attending school
- Meet Income Guidelines (see back)
- Have less than \$1 million in assets.
